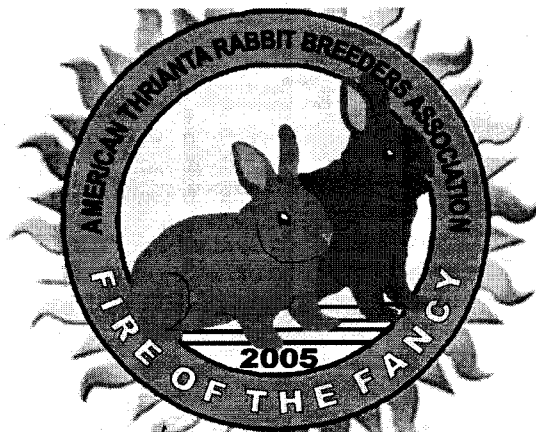

## ATRBA President's Message:



As most of you know our President, Bob Whitman, passed away after a brief and courageous battle with cancer. During his last days several of us, Carrol, Cindy, and Tim, visited with him via phone. He would always talk about his concerns for the ARBA, the rabbit industry, and for our Thrianta club. There was no one more compassionate nor more loyal to our breed and our club than Bob. He was a very dear friend to me. He went the extra mile to help me whenever I would call upon him for anything. He had a great mind for history and tradition as expressed in his publications. He wrote many, many, articles about the yesteryears and the early pioneers of many breeds of rabbits and especially the more uncommon breeds. He was a stellar champion of the rare breeds, concerned about their possible extinction. During his lifetime he traveled the world over and amassed a collection of rabbit materials, books, artifacts, figurines, pictures, and anything to do with rabbits. I visited him once at his home in Beaumont, Texas and was in total awe of his wonderful collection. It was second to none!!

Bob, thank you, thank you, for your leadership of our fledgling club and for your friendship.

We promise to carry on in your memory.

Upon Bob's death I, as vice president, was obligated under our club constitution to take over as president to complete Bob's term which expires on the first day of the ARBA convention in 2010. With Board

approval I have appointed Tim Branham to fulfill my current term as vice president which expires on the first day of the ARBA convention this fall. To complete Tim's position as a director until the ARBA convention in 2010, I appointed Brigette Armstrong of Oklahoma. A complete and working Board is in place to serve our membership.

This year an election for the office of vice president and three directors is required. Directors Duane Holman, Cindy Wickizer, and Bob Lloyd, are up for reelection. Letters of intent were tendered by Tim Branham for vice president, and by Cindy Wickizer, Bob Lloyd, and Susan Pohto for director. Duane Holman wished not to seek a third term. Because there will be no competition for any of these offices, the above named candidates will be elected by acclamation. Their respective terms of office will end at the 2011 ARBA convention. ### **ATRBA Director Bill Mairs**



Greetings from the Pacific North West

First and foremost, it is important to reflect upon the passing of Bob Whitman. As a fellow breeder who shared many of the same interests in rabbits, the greatest

impact Bob had on my present breeding herd occurred when we were at a show together in Europe. There, Bob convinced me to import Continentals. At a show in Holland, he suggested I get a pair of Thriantas and to do a unit shipment with him to share our costs. Following this, it was splitting a herd of Continentals from Austria. Every time we were overseas together it felt like we were kids in a candy shop – so many varieties of rabbits that we could potentially import! Approximately 6 years ago, I was losing interest in the rabbits and Bob was a man who had greatly influenced my decision to continue with raising rabbits and renewed the desire to breed and feel inspired by the imports. It was Bob who got me involved with the Thrianta Club. Bob, you will always be remembered and we will miss you. Rest in peace my friend.

At the Washington State Judges Conference, I presented a well received paper on "My Interpretation of Thrianta Judging" (refer to article in Fall 2009 newsletter). I still find ARBA judges have a preference for judging based upon type first then color. Most imported Thriantas have orange red coloring, however, I see a lot of North American Thriantas that are now New Zealand Red. This in my opinion is too dark. Judges should strive to comment on the items which are most important in the Standard. Because Thriantas are a new breed, most judges are still learning about them. Breeders seek feedback that is relevant to the specifics of the breed based on the Standard. As our club and breeders continue to grow and the judges have increasing exposure to Thriantas across North America, they will start putting more emphasis on color and fur before type as indicated in the Standard of Perfection.

This year on the West Coast we are all experiencing quite the unreal summer with record breaking temperatures. Over the years we have observed significant lethal effects upon imports and rabbits brought in from lower climate zones when we experience temperatures over 100-110 degrees. There is a tendency to lose upwards of 35% of those animals in the first year. Subsequent generation's fatality rate decrease as they acclimatize to our weather conditions. We have noted a true 'survival

of the fittest'. It is discouraging to lose good stock and expensive imports; however, it is encouraging to note that the stock that does survive will in turn be a stronger and more resilient breed.

Hope to see everyone at Convention!

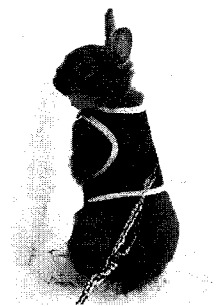

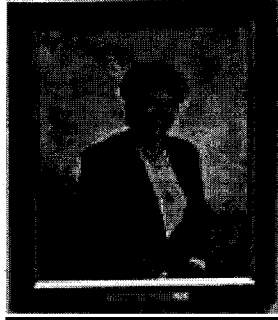

On June 10, 2009, the rabbit and plant world lost a knowledgeable and dedicated enthusiast. Less than 2 months after being diagnosed with cancer, our friend Bob Whitman lost the battle. He was called to care for the gardens and animals of heaven. Bobby's talents were unending and he never ceased to amaze everyone with his dedication to the plant and animal worlds. Bob was the Director of the Beaumont Botanical Gardens and was a hands-on inspiration to all. When you walk through the grounds you can see his many accomplishments, he has certainly left his mark and the propagation building is named for him. Bob traveled throughout the world and there are some wonderful pictures of him with many different plants and animals including lion cubs, birds, a Kuala and on and on. In the 1980's Bob visited Brazil. On a remote mountain top he discovered a previously unknown species of *Cryptanthus*, (Earth Star), which was later officially named in his honor, *Cryptanthus whitmanii*. He eventually introduced over 60 new species, cultivars and hybrids into the world of *Cryptanthus* plants.

As a very young man and throughout his life, Bob made a lasting impression on the rabbit world. The following are some of his amazing accomplishments toward the betterment of the rabbit world. Member of the ARBA since March 5, 1968; Awarded ARBA King In 1969; At that time, the youngest person to ever receive an ARBA Registrars License; Successfully presented the standard Hotot (Blanc D'Hotot) for recognition by the ARBA; Instrumental in founding the standard Hotot Rabbit Club of America; Life member of the Hotot Rabbit Breeders International; Patriot and life member of the Enderby Island Rabbit Club of New Zealand; Honorary member of the Rabbit Club of New Zealand; Founding member of the Lop Rabbit Club of America; Founding member of the Rhinelander Rabbit Club of America; Founding and life member

of the American Thrianta RBA; First and continuous President of the American Thrianta RBA (office held until his demise); Instrumental in building interest in rare breeds of rabbit not only in this country but also abroad; Imported more new rabbit breeds to this country than any other individual; Served as ARBA District 4 Director for two (2) terms and had filed petition for 3<sup>rd</sup>. term in the upcoming election; Throughout the years has served on various ARBA Committees, including Chair of the ARBA Library, devoting countless hours at the ARBA office working on the ARBA Library; Raised the funds to secure the largest collection of rabbit literature in the world for the ARBA Library, larger than that of the Library of Congress and the National Livestock Library; Cornerstone of the ARBA Domestic Rabbit magazine, writing the column "Historically Speaking"; Raised more money for the ARBA Conventions than any other person; As a fund raiser for the ARBA, wrote the cumulative index of every issue of the DR.; Secured the donation of \$13,000 to ARBA in order to buy two (2) used equipment trailers.; Author of " Domestic Rabbits & Their Histories - Breeds of the World"; Traced the complete history of the ARBA from the beginning; Wrote "1001 Ways To Cook Rabbit, The Complete Domestic Rabbit Cook Book", which is the largest cookbook ever written on the Domestic Rabbit, 362 pages; After 2-1/2 years of work, realized his goal of having the ALBC recognize the rabbit as livestock; An eight (8) page article in Rabbits USA was published on Bob Whitman, his devotion to domestic rabbits and his outstanding collections/artifacts of rabbits; Served as a consultant to the ALBC on a program to perform DNA cultures on breeds of rabbit to trace back to the originating breeds until his demise; Was commissioned to write a book on the "Hobby of Rabbit Farming" but was not able to complete; Has willed his entire rabbit collection/artifacts to the ARBA Library. These are only some of the rabbit projects to which he was devoted, but I believe you can all see why those of us who were close to him know what a treasure we have lost. Those of us who were close to him have lost a very dear and true friend.

## **Cindy's Tribute to Bob Whitman:**

I wish that I could be there in person today to look out of the people that are present. I feel that I know many of you personally by seeing you through Bob's eyes. I know "Mama" because Bob called his mother every morning at 8 A.M. He loved her and cared deeply about her and always spoke about her with pride and admiration. He would tell the stories about her early life in Germany and the hardships she endured. These were the family stories which had been passed down to him and that he remembered and considered part of his family history. Perhaps this was the spark that would take him on the journey to research, collect and write the individual stories of others. Perhaps it was the joy of having his first rabbit which sparked the journey. He was unique in the world and that is due to his mother.

Bob joined the American Rabbit Breeders Association as a youth member and even some forty years ago was active in the association. At an early age he had founded the Golden Triangle Rabbit Club, was President and Secretary of the Texas Youth Rabbit Club, and American Rabbit Breeders Association Youth Director. Bob was named American Rabbit Breeders Association King in 1970. The other young man who was one of Bob's main rivals at the time was Dr. Scott Williamson, who is now a professor at Cal State and still is very active in rabbits. At every convention where the two of them have been present since that time, they still talk of the rivalry of competing for that title. To listen to the two of them speak, you would have thought that the contest happened yesterday because each remembered it so vividly. Bob became the youngest ARBA Registrar at that time. He also imported some of the first English and French Lops into this country. It was at that time that he met and began corresponding with several of the legends of rabbit raising in England.

The ARBA convention was held in Calgary, Canada about 40 years ago and that is where I first met Bob. He was the young man who was following the founding fathers of the ARBA and gathering their stories.

They all knew him personally. James Bylth, the ARBA secretary at the time, had a couple of boxes of material which the Board of Directors did not want. They thought at the time that no one would be interested in all of the "old stuff." Bob was and when I first met him, he was reading old guidebooks and letters. Perhaps that was one of the sparks that led him in later life to raise the money and gather the largest collection of rabbit and cavy books in the world which were brought to the United States and put into the ARBA Hall of Fame Library in Bloomington, Illinois. That collection is a tribute to his understanding that the past had to be preserved.

His involvement through the years in the rabbit fancy had been numerous. He was a charter member of the Lop Rabbit Club of America, a charter member of the American Beveren Rabbit Club, Vice-President of the Himalayan Rabbit Club, founder of the Rhinelander Rabbit Club of America, Hotot Rabbit Club Secretary and Treasurer, North American Lionhead Club President, Thrianta Club President and American Rabbit Breeders Association District Director. He imported rare breeds of rabbits into this country and even had the Hotot accepted into the ARBA Standard of Perfection.

All of these accomplishments tell you who Bob was on the outside, but they do not tell you who Bob was on the inside. They do not tell you about the man beyond the sometimes gruff exterior who was very human. They do not tell you about the man who kept a calendar of events both past and present of events that had happened through rabbit history. You probably never met a person who would know be able to tell you that a founding father of the ARBA or a personal friend had been born or died on a certain date and how many years ago that had been. If you were his friend he did not forget your birthday or a special date in your life. If you needed to be able to discuss a problem or needed a shoulder to cry on, Bob was there. Once he was your friend, you could count on his loyalty for life. His word was his bond. I could count a thousand memories in my mind of conversations with Bob which stay precious.

I thought about making a list of things Bob loved, but the list got too long so I am going to just give you a few. The things that Bob did gave him a personal joy. Bob loved

Christmas! He started planning months ahead and we used to have a race to get trees up right after Thanksgiving. He had themed trees which reflected different interests. Bob would set up his Christmas trees just because he personally enjoyed them and loved to look at them. He had a beautiful Egyptian tree and his Special Memory Tree. He loved getting presents and was like a little kid! Of course my presents were never wrapped with the straight corners and edges that his always had. I often told him that he could have been an interior designer. He loved cooking Christmas Eve dinner, Christmas dinner and generally making new dishes and trying out new recipes. He loved his friend Connie's cooking. He loved to laugh and saw humor in situations. He loved church cathedrals! He loved stain glass! He loved Victorian homes! He loved old furniture! He loved unique glass and antiques! He loved flowers and plants! He loved to travel! He loved German cooking! He loved old rabbit books! He loved old rabbit prints! I could go on and on, but this gives you a small idea of what Bob appreciated. Very few of us are blessed to have known someone who so touched our lives in the way that Bob did. It is hard to even think about him not being a phone call away.

I would like to leave with you a few of the memories of the many memories that I will have. Bob and I were at the Tower of London. To paint the scene, you have to imagine that it is a dark gray day and we went to the Tower of London because there was a Sir Francis Drake exhibit and Bob thought that one of the old books in the exhibit would give some further insight into rare rabbit breeds. We are surrounded by hundreds of years of history with all of the magnificent tourist type pictures that can be taken, but Bob was most impressed with the Tower's Black Ravens. They are protected because of an old legend which says that the English Throne would fall if the Ravens left. Bob spent an hour trying to see how close he could get to the Ravens. He had Raven pictures and more Raven pictures! We traveled to Leipzig, Germany to the World Rabbit Show with a group of British rabbit fanciers. Everything had been carefully planned as we had to spend a couple of days on a tour bus. We had tried to figure out how many hours to sleep to

make sure that we could take full advantage of the time. Bob gave all of us the guided tour of where different rabbit breeds had originated. We had decided that we were going to try every German bread, candy and sweet that we could find. So when the tour bus reached the final destination, he and I went downtown to recapture the memories that we had of German baking. Along the way, we found antiques shops and all of the other things that each of us had remembered from our childhood. There were too many things that were left to do! Bob believed in miracles! He had a very deep faith in God. When he got sick and we kept praying for a miracle, he asked me one time if I would always remember him. We talked about the times we had talked and the many things that had happened in our lives and how they were intertwined forever. We kept praying for the miracle for Bob. In the past days, it has been extremely hard because God needed Bob more than we all did. Not a day goes by when I still do not hear his voice in my head, his laugh in my heart, or I want to reach for the phone just to see what is happening in his world and share what is happening in mine. I have been to several rabbit shows and we have talked about Bob and the many memories that we all have about him in our rabbit world. It has only been with the passage of this small amount of time that I have come to realize the miracle was Bob! He touched so many lives. He was respected around the world in the rabbit community. His legacy will live long after many of us are gone. He was the miracle in our lives!

### **Bill Mairs' Interpretation of Judging Thriantas:**

Thriantas are a relatively new breed to the Standard of Perfection, but they have existed in Europe for some time. My experience with the breed comes from the careful study that I have done over the course of several years not only on the North American continent, but also in Holland. I have raised numerous litters and have compared what we see in the European and American bloodlines that exist today. Since the acceptance of this breed in 2006, there are many more being

shown and thus the need for ARBA judges to know more about accurate judging of the animal.

The Thrianta has 50 points on color and fur. There are only 40 points on general type and of those only 25 points are on the body. Head and ear are worth 10 points and feet and legs are worth 5 points. There are 10 points on condition.

When I am judging a Thrianta, before I even remove the animal from the judging coop, I can determine the first 15 points of that rabbit. In most cases, they are doing a natural low stance in the judging coop.

Looking at them, you can determine the ears and the head out of the 10 points allowed for this. In my interpretation, I allow 4 points for the ears. (It is not specifically broken down this way in the standard.) I am looking for tablespoon ears that are thick, well furred and well placed in the 3-3.5 inch range to balance with the head. They should be faulted for thinner folded ears. In the head, I want to see a very bold broad head with well developed jowls for a value of 6 points. (This is not specifically broken down in the standard.) The other thing that I notice at this time is the feet and legs. They should be short and of medium bone. Fault should be given for long thin bone. The one correlation I tend to use a fair bit is: If the animal has thick sturdy ears, 95% of the time the bone will be good thick bone.

Once you take the animal out to examine it, you can check for type at this time. Type is worth only 25 points but most judges over value type. Typical comments will be: Long in shoulder, not high enough rise, pinched on lower hindquarters – standard interpretations of type faults. After raising over 400 Thriantas, I find that there may only be about 10% that are close coupled and start their rise right at the back of the ears. Most have a tendency to be longer in the rib. As you flip them over to examine for disqualifications, the most important part of the Thrianta should be evaluated. That is the color of the animal.

In my mind, color is divided into 3 parts on the Thrianta which includes the upper deck, the sides and the lower deck. (This is the top, sides and belly.) When evaluating color, all points have to be looked at. In my mind, I allow 10 points on the upper deck, 5 points on each side and 10 points on the bottom deck. As I am looking at color, I want to see

the brilliance continue right down to the skin. From the top of the rabbit, I want it to blend into the sides with the same intensity of color also to the skin. I am looking for a 360 degree blend from the top deck to the bottom deck. Normally, you start to lose color on the bottom of the rabbit on the inside of the back legs. Often points are docked for extremely light or faded markings and belly color. It is possible to have a completely blended color from the top to the bottom. The color should be a fiery brilliant orange / red of varying degrees that remain consistent of intensity and saturation throughout the entire 360 degrees of the animal.

Thriantas have a rollback coat with dense medium length of about 1-1.25 inches long. The fur is to have sufficient resistance to resume a smooth well-groomed appearance when stroked in any direction and should present as soft to the touch but not silky nor wooly or harsh. Fur is valued at 20 points. Some Thriantas have between 5/8 to 3/4 inch long fur. Basically, the density is not in this type of coat. This is where you see the flyback coat presented on the animal.

These coats should be faulted.

When you look the points for color, fur, head, ears, feet and legs, and condition most of the points on the animal are used. General type has a minor role in the overall determination of the animal's standard. Judges should strive to comment on the items which are most important in the standard. Because Thriantas are a new breed, most judges are still learning about them. Breeders seek feedback that is relevant to the specifics of the breed based on the standard.

Bob Lloyd moved to adjourn, second by Tim Branham, meeting adjourned 10:24 am.

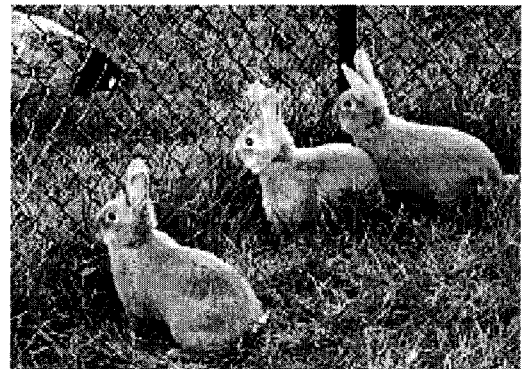

You must be a member in good standing of the ATRBA at the time the animals is shown in order to receive sweepstakes points, and at the time the awards are presented in order to receive the award. Awards shall be presented at the annual meeting to the winners of 1<sup>st</sup>. through 10<sup>th</sup>. Place. All ATRBA members in good standing at the time of the show shall be awarded normal earned points and in addition, each eligible exhibitor shall receive 100 additional points for exhibiting at the ARBA National Convention and/or at the ATRBA National show.

Explanation: At this time the top 5 places in each class receive normal ARBA points which are doubled for showing at either the ARBA Convention or the ATRBA National Show. If this proposed resolution is accepted by the membership, the top five places will receive normal ARBA points and every eligible Thrianta Exhibitor will receive 100 points for exhibition in either show. In other words, 6<sup>th</sup> place through however many are places will receive 100 points.

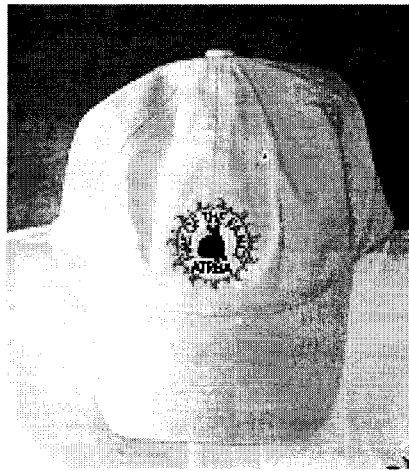

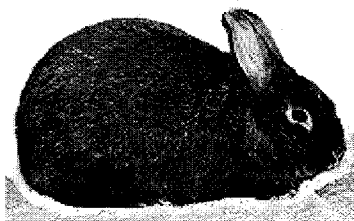

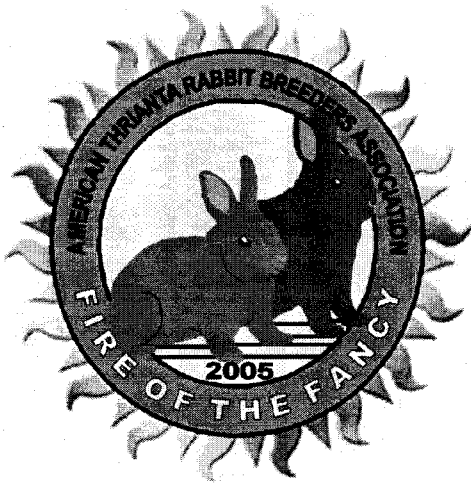
