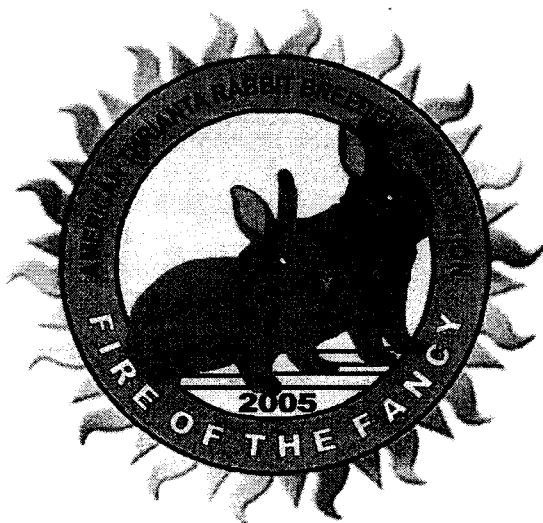

What a fantastic ARBA Convention last October in Louisville! Especially, the Thriantas portion. When I looked up the entries of the various breeds on the Internet prior to the opening of the convention, I was elated to see over 300 Thriantas entered combined in open and youth classes. This number, I believe exceeded more than half the entries of the other 46 recognized breeds. I had to kid my good friend, Tex Thomas, as there were less Silver Martens entered. His favorite breed. Neither of us expected such a rapid rise in popularity of our little red rabbits. "How cool", as the younger generation would say!

Judge Tim Branham worked almost the entire day on Monday sorting through four sizeable classes in the open show, with sixty or more in three classes and nearly 50 in another. I'm sure the results are elsewhere in this newsletter or you may find them on our web site. Again, this year I was quite impressed with the depth of quality and even more impressed with the overall improvement of our breed compared to prior years. I went up and down the rows many times admiring many animals in their coops owned by many various breeders. Certainly, no one has a lock on having good animals. Excellent animals were present from many parts of our United States and Canada. The judging went very smoothly thanks to the assistance of Jacquie Branham taking down all the judges remarks and the exhibitors doing the carrying duties. We truly have an enthusiastic, friendly group.

Once again the Thrianta booth was a showcase of awards, prizes, raffle items, pictures, decorated in fall colors including an array of colorful gourds which caught the eye of many passersby. Kim & Sarah Glass, Amanda Pitsch, Elmer & Brian Brumley & Jacquie Branham did a superb job creating such a beautiful booth. A big thank you to everyone who contributed items and worked on the booth.

The Wednesday morning breakfast was like last year's, fantastic! With an all one could consume buffet and a private area to make our presentations of awards and conduct our business meeting made for a great event. I think everyone attending won a prize of some sort. Thank you again to Kim and Amanda for all of their work.

The auction was again a huge success. There were over 30 Thriantas put up for sale. Dick Daniels was able to fit us in his tight schedule and did a fine job auctioning off every animal in good time. We set a record for the sale of one Thrianta at \$380.00. The club realized proceeds from the auction of nearly \$500.00. Not bad. Thanks to all that put animals in the auction and to all of the buyers. There were some really nice animals selling for very reasonable prices. I bought two for way under what I thought they were worth.

The next ARBA convention will be in Del Mar, California. I realize that our numbers will be down but I hope our west coast members will make every effort to fill the classes and a few from back eastward will show up as well. Our new director, Cindy Wickizer, has agreed to coordinate our events at this convention.

Its not too early to plan to attend our third National Show in Columbus, Ohio on May 2, 2009. Tim & Jacquie Branham have again volunteered to manage this show. We have secured a fine judge, Caleb Thomas of Indiana, to do the honors. We need donations for awards and for the raffle table. Contact Tim & Jacquie. Most of all we need exhibitors. We promise you will have a great time.

The ATRBA Standard Committee has approved a statement to be added to the next revision of the ARBA Standard of Perfection. It is a statement regarding the desired placement or carriage of the head. It seems there is a varied opinion as to the proper carriage and some judges have questioned what is proper. Please read the proposed addition statement that is provided in this issue. For the ARBA Standards Committee to consider any change to our standard it must first be approved by a majority of our membership. Each member should receive a ballot. Please take the time to vote.

Recently, it was mentioned to me that some judges neglect to include the belly color when evaluating the color of a Thrianta. They stroke and blow into the coat over the back but never roll the animal to look at the belly color. We are still in a mode of educating breeders and judges alike as to the importance of uniform color over the entire body including the belly. I would encourage breeders to visit with judges after the show to discuss the desired color over the entire animal when this may happen.

My last item of business is to report that specific judges were recommended to the Board of Directors by a committee appointed by President Whitman at Louisville, to judge at future conventions, up to and including 2015. Upon approval of the Board and final confirmation by these judges our judges will be Cindy Wickizer, 2010, John Soper, 2011, Ruth Ann Bell, 2012, vacant for 2013, Tim Branham, 2014, and Phil Woollet, 2015. Many national specialty clubs secure commitments from judges many years in advance to retain their choices. It was felt we should do the same thus we have secured quality judges for our breed. One year is yet to be filled. Anyone that may wish to nominate a judge please send it to me for consideration of the committee.

With all the negative news these days about our economy, bailouts, joblessness, etc. let's all resolve to make the best of 2009 and enjoy our Thriantas. Happy New year everyone.

The OSRBA provides cooping for our rabbits and all animals entered in our National Thrianta Show must be cooped. There will be plenty of coop tags available at the booth. See the show flyer located elsewhere in this issue for additional information. The OSRBA will have a Thrianta Specialty on Saturday after our show and an All Breed Show on Sunday. You will have the opportunity to show your Thriantas 3 times over the weekend. We hope to have a really great raffle and need everyone to bring raffle items. If you any other questions about the show that are not covered in the ad, call Tim or Jackie Branham as they have graciously agreed to serve again as our Superintendent and Secretary. Our National Show Judge will be a fellow Thrianta enthusiast Caleb Thomas. We really hope you will be able to be a part of our National Thrianta Show.

ATRBA Guidebook: Amanda Pitsch is diligently working on our guidebook. Yes, it is very late, but we are moving forward now. If you have not previously done so and you would like to include an ad or an article, contact Amanda to see if there is still time. This guidebook will be around for several years and one will be sent to all current members.

Changes to Constitution and By-Laws: I have been told there are some proposed resolutions to be submitted but as of this time I have not received any. The requirements for submitting resolutions to the Constitution and By-Laws are located elsewhere in this issue. All resolutions must be received by the Secretary/Treasurer a minimum of 90 days prior to the annual membership meeting at the ARBA Convention. If you have any questions, contact Constitution and By-Laws Chairman Tim Branham or me. If you cannot find your copy of the Constitution and By-Laws please contact me and I can mail or email one to you.

2008 Election: Our election process is quickly approaching. If you are interested in running for office in our club you need to contact this office for a "Letter of Intent". This being an odd year, the office of Vice President and three directors are up for election. Glen Carr, Duane Holman, Bob Lloyd and Cindy Wickizer are all eligible for re-election. There have been some questions as to who is eligible for re-election. Although our paperwork had been in the ARBA office for quite a long time, our officers and directors did not become official with the ARBA until February of 2006. Therefore, no one has served the maximum of three - two year terms. We encourage all who are interested to run for an office in our club. Per our constitution the requirements for seeking election are: "In order to seek election, any member over age 18 and having been a member in good standing for at least one (1) year wishing to become a candidate for any elective office of this Association shall submit a "letter of intent" listing the member's name, and office for which the member desires to be a candidate, be signed by the member and sent to the Secretary by mail, postmarked no later than June 15 prior to election. E-mail is not acceptable."

I hope all of you have lots of little red rabbits to show this spring. It is time to start planning your breeding calendar for the 2009 ARBA National in California. I had a lot of babies born this month but it went from 17 degrees to 80 degrees in just over 24 hours so I lost all but three. Those three are healthy and beautiful but it is really a challenge raising these little guys. I never had much trouble with the Satins or Cals (or any of the other breeds), but these are a whole new challenge. I get discouraged but then I go to the barn and forget all the hard times. I have never spent time "scratching, petting, loving on" any rabbits until these little red guys. When they hear you come in the barn they come to the front of the cage for their "attention". They are so sweet and you just can't help but love them. Yes, occasionally you find an aggressive one, and no matter what you do you cannot change that trait. I don't mind the mommas being so protective, but I cannot tolerate a "mean" one. But, those are far and few between and are the exception and not the rule with our breed.

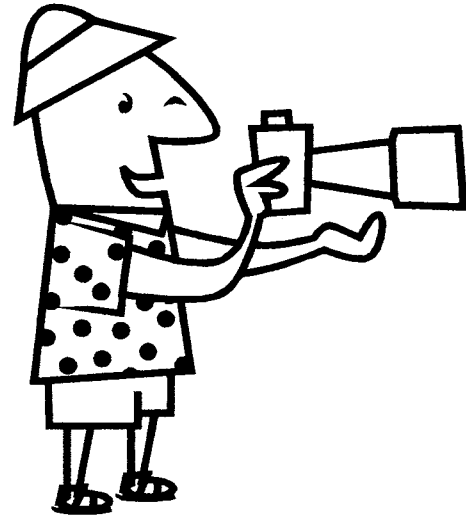

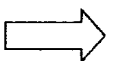
